## on your public access cable station!

Almost all public access station managers welcome video submissions from local residents. "Populist Dialogues" is available for free download from PegMedia (PegMedia.org), a media sharing site for public, education and government community stations, which makes it especially easy and accessible. Here's how your local station can select, download, and air shows.

First, go to the Populist Dialogues website (www.populistdialogues.org) or the show's YouTube channel (www.youtube.com/PopulistDialogues). New shows are posted weekly. With a variety of topics, there is bound to be a show of interest to your community.

Contact your local public access TV station and talk to the programming manager to find out how they schedule shows. Most stations have open time spots that they need to fill. Learn from them if they are interested in just one show, or topic, or running a new show each week.

Your local station can then download the show directly from PegMedia. It's easy for them to do!

- 1. They should go to PegMedia's website at pegmedia.org
- 2. If your local station doesn't already have an account, they can create one by clicking on "Create New Account"
- 13. After establishing the new account, they will log in.
- 4. Now click on: Shows from Selected States
- 5. Select "Oregon"
- 6. Click on: Alliance for Democracy—Populist Dialogues
- 7. Now read the brief description of the series and scroll down to view list of currently available shows. You can find download instructions on the right hand link: "Downloading Show Episodes"

Note that there is no cost to your station thanks to the Portland Alliance for Democracy chapter covering the fee. **So don't wait—share the shows and be the media!**
